
We're honored that you are taking the time to get to know more about our family. We want you to know that we understand this isn't a decision that you are making lightly. It takes courage, time, and most importantly love.

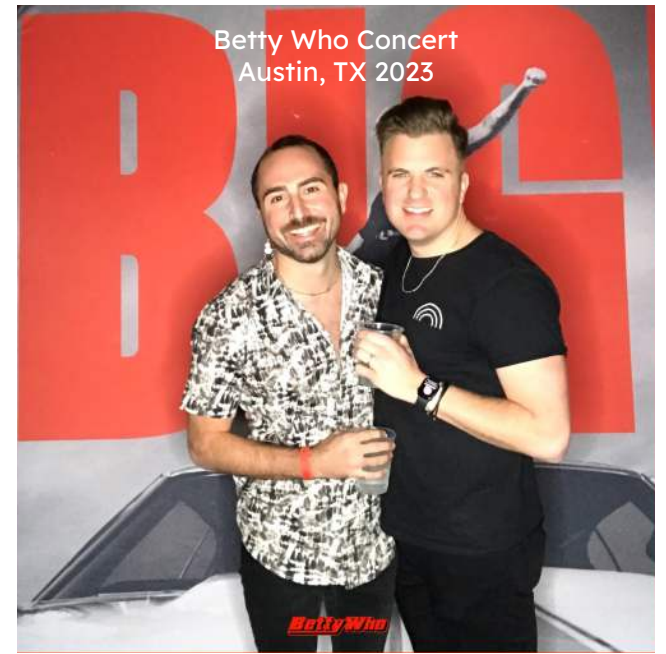
# OUR STORY

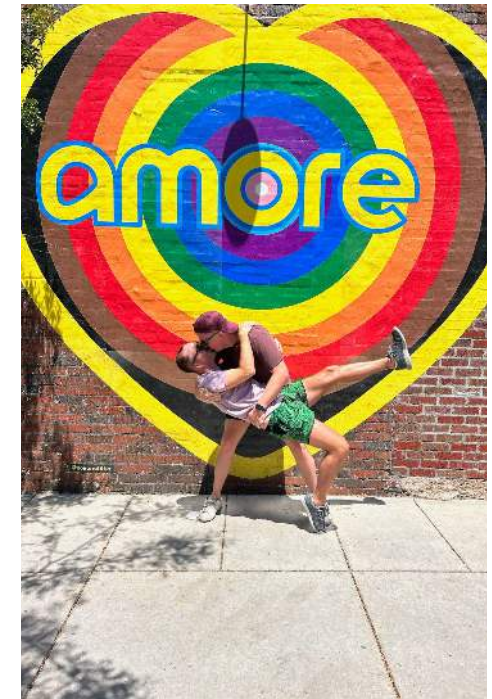


## WHAT I LOVE ABOUT MICAH

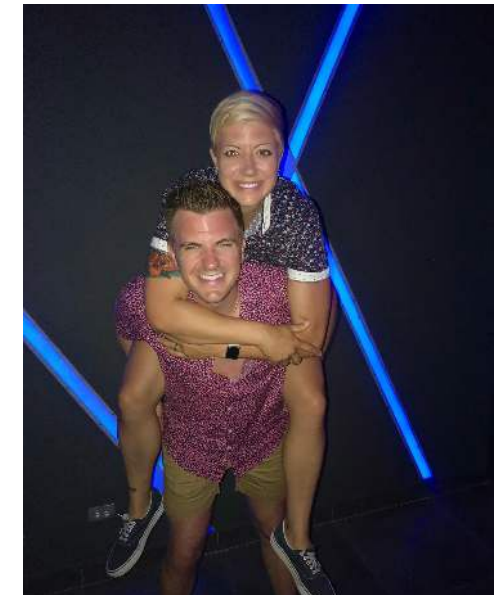

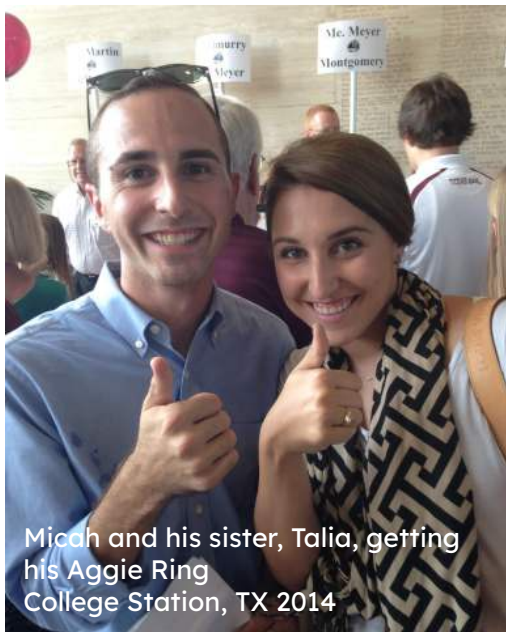
# HEY! I'M MICAH.

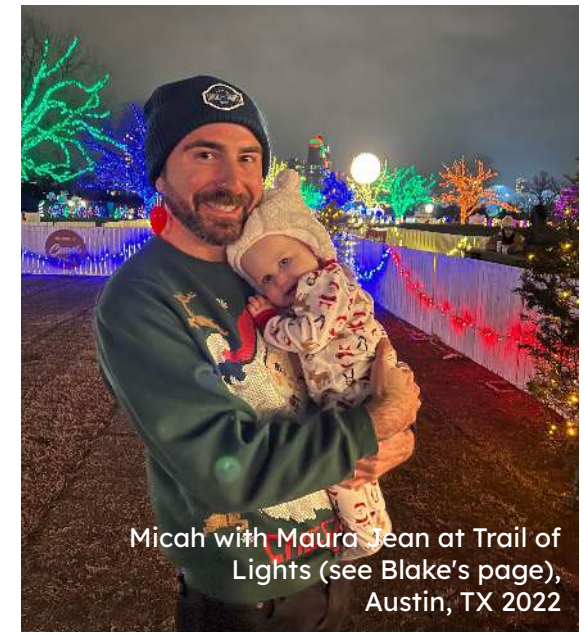

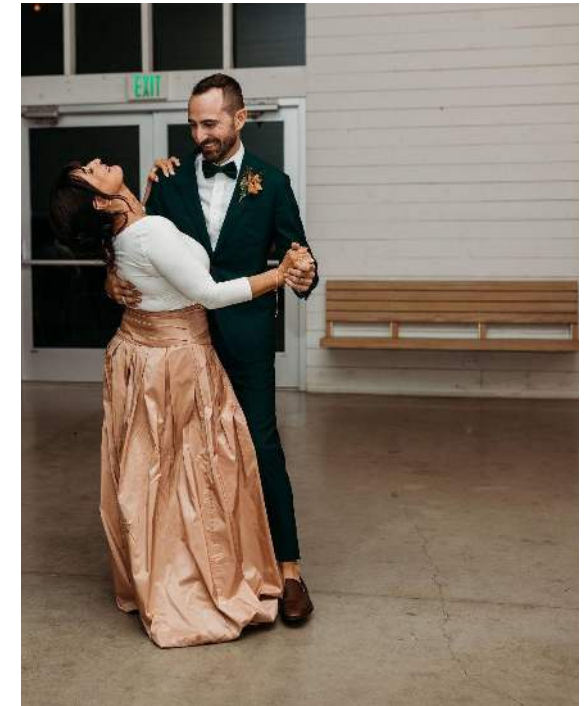

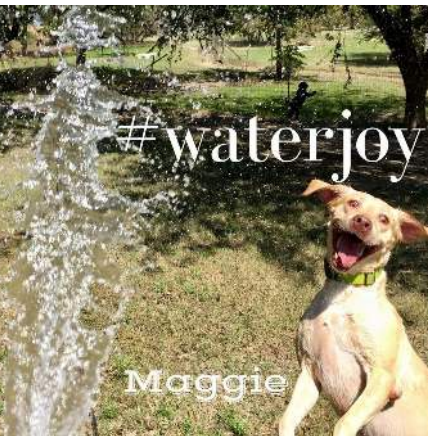

And in a corner of our home, a nursery (and a little library) is already taking shape, getting ready for our newest additions.

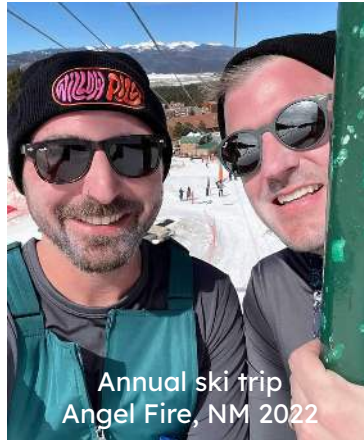
